## Upcoming Free Recycling Events (All Events Open to Calhoun County Residents Only):

- **June 1, 2019**

***Household Hazardous Waste Collection***

10 AM to 12 PM

Toeller Building parking lot, 190 E. Michigan Ave., Battle Creek

**Items Accepted:** Old gasoline, kerosene, fuel oil (must be in approved container), brake fluid, pesticides, old prescriptions, anti-freeze, solvents, cleaners, stain and oil based paint, acids, pool chemicals, aerosol cans, household batteries (includes button), mercury, fluorescent light bulbs, CFL bulbs, sharps sealed in a coffee can or laundry detergent bottle. **NO latex paint.**

- **June 25, 2019**

***Scrap Tire Collection***

Village of Tekonsha Offices, 537 N. Church St., Tekonsha

**Items Accepted:** Calhoun County residents may bring up to 10 passenger vehicle tires. No over-sized tires or business related tires will be unloaded. No early drop-off. Event may end early if the semi-trailer fills before 5 PM.

**Scrap Metal:** Any metal items that do not contain refrigerant. Tagged items accepted.
